



Traffic Management and Control Plan

Rush Hour

During rush hour, vehicles enter and remain within the intersections stopping cross traffic from flowing. In an effort to improve the flow of traffic, officers will be assigned to high traffic intersections in order to direct vehicles not to remain within the intersection during traffic signal changes. This plan is implemented whenever a major intersection displays the need for an officer's presence.

Schools

Without direction, parents are lost regarding pick-up and drop-off procedures at schools. Officers from the Special Services Unit are assigned to public schools within the Town. From the first day of school, officers educate the parents of the correct procedures for dropping-off and picking up their children. This plan has been implemented since the Town's inception and has been successful every year.

Projects and Special Events

During the planning stages of a construction project or special event, a Town police section representative will be present. The representative will coordinate in conjunction with the Project Supervisor, or event coordinator, to ensure all parties are in consensus regarding the importance of maintaining a constant flow of traffic and the safety of the citizens. This plan is implemented prior to the start of any project or special event.

Traffic Control Device Maintenance

Police personnel will remain vigilant for traffic control devices which are in need of repair/replacement. Upon observance, police personnel will take immediate action to ensure the device is back in service as soon as possible. Action will consist of, and is not limited to, contacting Division of Traffic Signs and Signals, and also contacting the Town's Public Works Director.
