Vice Mayor Pulido Will Host Quarterly Homeowner's and Condominium Association Meeting at Town Hall

Miami Lakes, Florida- On Monday June 22, 2009 at 6:30PM, Vice-Mayor Richard Pulido will host his quarterly homeowner's (HOA's) and condominium association (CA's) meeting at Town Hall in the large conference room on the third floor. This event is free and open to the public.

The meeting's format is an informal roundtable discussion bringing the Presidents of the Town's HOA's and CA's together with Town officials to focus on topics of interest such as public safety, code, and public works. These meetings provide the community leaders the opportunity to give the Town an update on the status of their respective neighborhoods while enabling the Town to respond to the homeowner's concerns.

Speaking at the last HOA and CA meeting in late February, Vice-Mayor Pulido stated: "I'm grateful that the Town of Miami Lakes understands the importance of our HOA's and CA's and that these meetings give an opportunity for us to continue to work together on finding ways to improve our Town."

In past forums, homeowner's have been provided the opportunity to ask questions of department personnel and listen to their respective updates and presentations. The Police Department's most recent presentation yielded interest from residents who wish to receive a crime report via email on a regular basis and Police hope to see this email list grow.

Vice-Mayor Pulido, understanding that the HOA Board Members are volunteers charged with protecting their neighbor's home values, encourages all homeowners to participate in the upcoming HOA and CA meeting.
