This addendum is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the Invitation to Bid (ITB) 2012-02. The following may include clarifications, revisions, additions, deletions, and/or answers to questions received relative to the ITB, which take precedence over the ITB documents. Underlined word(s) indicate additions and deletion are indicated by strikethrough.

Requests for Information/Clarification:

1. **Question:** Will the Town allow Contractors to dispose of Tree Trimming debris at sites within Miami-Dade County other than those operated by Miami-Dade County, which require the Landscape Permit?

Answer: Subject to the following conditions a Bidder may be authorized to dispose of Tree Trimmings at a site that does not require the Tree Permit. The proposed disposal site(s), which must be identified below, must be licensed to receive the Tree Trimmings and be capable of providing the Contractor documents of disposal. Such sites and the documentation to be provided to the Town documenting disposal shall be subject to the review and approval of the Town prior to award. During the Bid evaluation process the Town may require the Bidder to submit any necessary documentation to evaluate the alternative site(s). Bidder may identify up to two (2) alternate site(s). Approval of alternate sites shall be at the sole discretion of the Town. Bidders who will dispose of the Tree Trimmings at a Miami-Dade County operated facility are required to meet the minimum requirement for possession of the Landscape Permit(s).

2. **Question:** Must the Contractor possess a Landscape License/Certification to perform the Work?

Answer: Yes. To meet the minimum requirements a Bidder must possess the necessary license(s) to perform Tree Trimming Services.

3. **Question:** Can the Bidder apply insecticide/pesticide for whitefly or other treatments without subcontracting?

Answer: Yes, subject to meeting the requirements of Article 3.39 which requires compliance with all Federal, State of Florida, Miami-Dade County and Town laws, rule, regulations, codes, and ordinances, which includes meeting all licensing requirements for the commercial application of insecticides/pesticides.
