

ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 81

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-59; AMENDING THE TOWN'S BUDGET FOR THE 2004-2005 FISCAL YEAR; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes and Section 8.7 of the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") Charter, the Town Council adopted the Budget for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 (the "Budget") by Ordinance No. 2004-59; and

**WHEREAS**, Fiscal Year 2004-2005 ended on September 30, 2005 and thereafter, in accordance with Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the Town's auditors and Finance Director completed their review of the actual expenditures and revenues against those adopted in the Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has determined that it is necessary to amend the Budget, as set forth in Exhibit "A," based upon the review and analysis by the auditors and the Finance Director and further based upon the recommendations of the Town Manager.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2. Budget Amendment.** The Budget for Fiscal Year 2004-05 adopted in Ordinance 2004-59 is amended and replaced in its entirety with the Final Budget attached as Exhibit

“A.” All other terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 04-59 not otherwise amended by this Ordinance remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3. Authorization of Town Manager.** The Town Manger is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption on second reading.
