

RESOLUTION NO. 01-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, CREATING THE “YOUTH ACTIVITIES TASK FORCE”; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires that a task force be created to explore the development of positive youth activities for this coming summer and thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that the task force should include a representative of the Miami Lakes Civic Association, the Miami-Dade County Police Department and concerned residents of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby creates a task force to be known as the “Youth Activities Task Force.”

Section 2. The Youth Activities Task Force shall consist of nine members. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Town Council. Two members shall represent and belong to the Miami Lakes Civic Association; two members shall be residents of the Town appointed at-large; one member shall represent the Miami-Dade Police Department and be assigned to the Town of Miami Lakes; two members shall be high school students that reside in the Town; and the remaining two members shall be selected from residents nominated by the members of the Town Council. Each Councilmember shall be entitled to nominate one resident.

Section 3. The Youth Activities Task Force shall prepare a report to the Town Council on its activities at least once every three months.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


