A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF REDLAND; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the area of unincorporated Miami Dade County known as "Redland" has long desired to become a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the areas of Miami Lakes and Palmetto Bay were approved by the Miami Dade County Commission for incorporation after completing certain defined procedures; and

WHEREAS, Redland has completed the County procedures required to move forward towards incorporation; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Miami Lakes is a proponent of municipal government; and

WHEREAS, incorporation is the "wave of the future" in Miami Dade County.



Section 1. **Recitals** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.


Section 2. The Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes supports the incorporation efforts of the future City of Redland and the right of the residents to vote on incorporation.
