


Florida Department of Transportation



- The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) coordinates the planning and development of safe, viable, and balanced state transportation system serving all regions in the state.
- FDOT reports directly to the governor and has seven districts.
- District Six serves Miami-Dade County and Monroe County.

FDOT District Six Work Program


District 6: Total Budget Overview 2016-2020



- The Department has programmed approximately \$3.75 billion for transportation product, support, operations and maintenance, fixed capital, and other products over the next five years.


- The product budget includes money spent on construction, public transportation, right-of-way, and other product.

District 6: Product Overview 2016-2020



- \$2.1 billion (75.9%) construction projects
- \$413.8 million (15.3%) public transportation programs and services
- \$204.1 million (7.5%) purchasing of right-of-way
- \$34.5 million (1.3%) other product which consist of County Transportation Programs










