

## Freebee Sanitation precautions in Response to COVID-19

1. All Brand Ambassador Drivers are required to wear face coverings and gloves while conducting service.
2. All Freebee passengers are required to wear face coverings, as per Miami Dade County Emergency Order 20-20. Passengers in violation of this order will be denied boarding to any Freebee vehicle.
3. Freebee service will be limited to single trips and not multiple trips (No pooled rides).
4. Passengers will not be allowed to sit next to the driver and the number of riders will be limited to a maximum of four (4) passengers per one (1) group.
5. Passengers will not be allowed to board Freebee if they are sick or have flu like symptoms.
6. All Freebee vehicles will be disinfected to begin each shift.
7. Passengers are no longer allowed to ride in the front seat of our vehicles for the time being.
