# West Lakes Phase IV Drainage Improvement Project

#### **Project Summary and Benefits**

The project consists of drainage improvements funded through the Stormwater Utility System Revenue Bonds and Division of Emergency Management (DEM) to continue the Town's commitment to mitigate flooding. The drainage improvements include the construction of an exfiltration trench, partial new gutters, asphalt milling and resurfacing.

### What's Happening

Starting June 2nd, 2025 ATC Engineering, Inc (Contractor) will commence drainage work for the West Lakes Phase IV (NW 153rd Terrace) Drainage Improvements Project. The project will impact the following Roads: NW 153<sup>rd</sup> Terrace, NW 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, NW 91<sup>st</sup> Court, NW 90<sup>th</sup> Court, NW 90<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 89<sup>th</sup> Place. The project is estimated to be completed by December 2025.

#### What you need to Know

- There will be road closures with signalized detours to allow for continuous traffic flow.
- Due to road closures, drivers may experience delays when traveling in the area.
- Please follow detour sign routes and abide by all traffic laws.
- Please use caution when driving, cycling, or walking in the area.

The Contractor is also required to maintain local vehicular traffic during working hours and all lanes of vehicular traffic during non-working hours. However, there may be circumstances when a lane may need to remain closed during non-working hours. The contractor will leave a signalized detour to direct traffic. You may experience some delays and inconveniences during this time, and in this regard, we ask for your cooperation and patience. We also request that when driving or walking through and around the construction area, you follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.
