The Town Manager, Alex Rey, gave a brief introduction of the outline for the proposed strategic plan for the Budget Plan of FY2019 and gather feedback from the Town Council regarding priorities for the plan.

Deputy Town Manager, Andrea Agha, presented an overview of the attached presentation which included items regarding the mobility plan, the parks and recreation beautification plan and the strategies to fund these initiatives through the 2025 Strategic Plan. Andrea also touched upon the expected finish for the current year's budget, a recap of the business plan initiatives for the following fiscal year which are consistent with the strategic plan,

and the current unfunded items that will be discussed for possible funding by the Town Council.

After some discussion, the Town Council listed their priorities, in order, to include the following as projects of consideration:

1. Miami Lakes Police Department Serve as Regularly Scheduled Additional Security at Local Schools
2. West Lakes Reforestation Phase 3
3. Virtual Town Hall
4. Develop & Implement a Sustainability Action Plan
5. Healthy Miami Lakes Master Plan
6. Smart Cities Strategic Roadmap


Honorable mentions:

**ADJOURNMENT:**


There being no further business to come before the Council, the workshop adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
