Town Manager, Edward Pidermann presented the PowerPoint on Legislative Priorities and went over the set of water and drainage projects, infrastructure, roads, and bridges projects, and legislative statutory and policy items. It was explained that these projects were adopted as preliminary and is now being presented for Representative Fabricio's feedback. Town Manager Pidermann stated the final adoption of the priorities list will be at the January Council Meeting.

Representative Fabricio then gave his input on the projects and asked to be sent all language for each project to review. He also stated projects have a higher likelihood of occurring if they are under \$1 million and if there are 50/50 matching funds. He also added that the optics on the Optimist Park are negative in light of other priorities statewide at this time and that Phase II and III projects have better likelihood of success.

Town Manager Pidermann, Public Works Director Omar Santos, and State Representative Fabricio answered all questions posed by the Town Council. The Town Council also asked to bring this back in January for final approval of their priorities in order.
