ORDINANCE NO. OI-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE MILLAGE RATE OF THE TOWN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2001 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2002, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser ("Property Appraiser") has certified the Town's taxable value for the year 2001 which includes all real property within the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town"); and

WHEREAS, On July 30, 2001, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 01-33 determining the proposed millage rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2001 and further scheduled the public hearing required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes to be held on Monday, September 24, 2001 at 6:00 p.m. at Miami Lakes Middle School, 6245 Miami Lakeway North, Miami Lakes, Florida; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the Town's millage rate has been noticed for Monday, September 24, 2001 at 6:00 p.m. at Miami Lakes Middle School, 6245 Miami Lakeway North, Miami Lakes, Florida, and all interested parties have had the opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council and the Town Manager have reviewed the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 budget for the Town and have considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures contemplated for in the budget and have determined that the levy set forth below provides the necessary funds for such expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. The Town Council establishes and adopts the millage rate of 3.057 mills for the 2001 tax year, or \$3.057 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Town of Miami Lakes.
- Section 3. The Tax Collector is directed to proceed with the collection and enforcement of the taxes levied herein as authorized by law.
- Section 4. Notice. The Town Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Ordinance to the County Property Appraiser; the County Tax Collector; and the Florida Department of Revenue.
- Section 5. Conflicts. All sections or parts of sections of the Miami-Dade County Code, as it may apply to the Town, that conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 6. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
- Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on second reading.
