

RESOLUTION NO. 23-1916

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR RFP 2023-08, DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES TO DEBRISTECH, LLC, THE HIGHEST-RANKED PROPOSER AND GOODWYN MILLS CAWOOD, LLC, THE SECOND HIGHEST-RANKED PROPOSER; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the “Town”) requires disaster debris monitoring services during disaster or emergency events; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article V, Division 2, Section 2-157 of the Town Code provides that procurements in excess of \$15,000 shall require the use of competitive sealed bidding; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 2, Article V, Division 2, Section 2-157 of the Town Code, the Town issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) No. 2023-08 on February 8, 2023, for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services; and

WHEREAS, the RFP was advertised in the Miami Daily Business Review as well as online via two public bidding websites, DemandStar and Public Purchase, and was physically posted in the Government Center Lobby; and

WHEREAS, the Town received two (2) proposals by the proposal deadline from:

1. DebrisTech, LLC
2. Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC

WHEREAS, an Evaluation Committee was appointed comprised of the following individuals:

1. Jeremy Bajdaun, Director of Parks and Recreation, Town of Miami Lakes
2. Omar Santos-Baez, Public Works Director, Town of Miami Lakes
3. Daniel Angel, Director of Building, Town of Miami Lakes; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee recommended awarding contracts to DebrisTech, LLC, to act as the primary contractor and Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC, to act as the secondary contractor for the services requested in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager concurs with the finding of the Evaluation Committee and recommends the approval of contracts DebrisTech, LLC, to act as the primary contractor and Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC, to act as the secondary contractor for disaster debris monitoring services; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council approves the recommendations of the Town Manager and authorizes the Town Manager to enter into contracts with DebrisTech, LLC, to act as the primary contractor and Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC, to act as the secondary contractor for disaster debris monitoring services, for a period of three (3) years with the option to renew the agreement for two (2) additional one-year terms, in an amount to be allocated on an as-needed basis in response to a disaster event on an as-needed basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. **Approval of the Contract.** The Town Council hereby approves the award of contracts with DebrisTech, LLC, to act as the primary contractor and Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC, to act as the secondary contractor in substantially the form attached hereto as

Exhibit “A” for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services (hereinafter referred to as “Contract”) in an amount to be allocated on an as-needed basis.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Officials. The Town Manager, his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all steps necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the Contract.

Section 4. Execution of the Contract. The Town Manager is authorized to execute the Contracts with DebrisTech, LLC and Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC, and to execute any extension and/or amendments to the Contract, subject to approval as to form and legality by the Town Attorney, and the authority to expend budgeted funds.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


