## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-1468**

COUNCIL A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF THE TOWN **OF** MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE ADOPTION OF A LINE ITEM BUDGET BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO FUND THE STUDY OF ROCK MINING BLASTS PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the May 2, 2017 Town Hall Meeting, Councilman Frank Mingo presented a new business item regarding support for a budget line item to fund the study of rock mining blasts and their effects, currently under consideration by the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the study of rock mining blasts may aid in the creation of statewide vibration standards for mining activity, and address the legitimacy of property damage caused by rock mining blasts; and

**WHEREAS**, both the Florida State House of Representatives and Senate have agreed to provide \$325,000.00 towards the rock mining study; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council supports this measure and urges the Governor for the State of Florida to approve this budget line item; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes this resolution is in the best interest of the Town of Miami Lakes.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> Request for approval of budget line item. The Town Council requests that the Governor for the State of Florida approve and execute the budget line item for the study of rock mining blasts, their effects and review of damage claims caused by mining activity.

<u>Section 3.</u> Authorization of Town Official. The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
