

RESOLUTION NO. 22-1805

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO TOWN CODE CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE XII, DIVISION 2, CO-DEDICATING CEDAR COURT, SGT EDDY PEREZ COURT; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO TOWN MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (RUANO)

WHEREAS, during the October 12, 2021, Town of Miami Lakes (the “Town”) Council meeting, the Town passed an item co-dedicating Cedar Court after Miami Lakes Resident and decorated police officer Sergeant Eddy Perez, who passed away from COVID-19 complications; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council found that honoring Sergeant Eddy Perez was important and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 13, Article XII, Division 2 of the Town Code, provides the exclusive method by which Town facilities can be dedicated and named; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 13, pursuant to Article XII, Division 2 of the Town Code, on January 11, 2022, the Town held a Public Hearing of which proper notice was provided to residents residing within 300 feet of Cedar Court; and

WHEREAS, after hearing testimony provided by Staff and the Public, the Town Council finds that Cedar Court should be co-designated Sgt. Eddy Perez Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Renaming of Cedar Court. Pursuant to the Town Code, the Town Council hereby adopts this resolution and co-dedicates Cedar Court, Sgt Eddy Perez Court.

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Section 3. **Authorization of Town Officials.** The Town Manager and/or his designee are authorized to expend budgeted funds to create the necessary signage to achieve Section 2 of this Resolution.

Section 4 **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


