

ORDINANCE NO. 14- 178

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 05-66, AS AMENDED, AND ORDINANCE 13-162; ADOPTING A REVISED BUILDING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2005, the Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes (the “Town”) adopted a Building Permit Fee Schedule for the Building Department in Ordinance No. 05-66;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 05-66 was subsequently amended by Ordinance Nos. 05-76, 08-100, 09-110, 10-126, and 13-162; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Town to adopt the following amendments to the Building Permit Fee Schedule, replacing the existing Building Permit Fee Schedule in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby finds and declares that adoption of this Ordinance is necessary, appropriate and advances the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Amendments to Building Permit Fee Schedule. The Building Permit Fee Schedule attached hereto¹. as Exhibit “A” shall replace in its entirety the Building Department Permit Fee Schedule currently adopted in Town Ordinance No. 05-66 as amended by Ordinance Nos. 05-76, 08-100, 09-110, 10-126, and 13-162.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All provisions of the Code of the Town of Miami Lakes that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 5. Inclusion in the Town Code. It is the intention of the Town Council, and it is hereby ordained, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Town Code and that if necessary the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intentions; and that the word “Ordinance” shall be changed to “Article”, “Division” or other appropriate word.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption on second reading.
