12. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Alleviating School Overcrowding (Pizzi)**

Mayor Pizzi made a motion to enter into an agreement with Miami Dade County Public School and allocate \$20,000.00 from the Education Advisory Committee for an antifraud program to proactively ensure that school overcrowding is reduced at Bob Graham Education Center. Councilmember Pulido made a friendly amendment directing the Town Manager to see if Miami Dade County Public Schools is willing to accept \$10,000.00 and include Miami Lakes K-8 Center in the agreement. The motion received a second from Vice Mayor Perdomo and all voted in favor.

The Mayor called for a recess at 8:15 p.m.

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m.

C. "No Parking" Zone on NW 80 Avenue and Allocation of Funds for Crosswalk on Commerce Boulevard and NW 80 Avenue (Hernandez)

Councilmember Hernandez made a motion to install a "No Parking" sign at Commerce Boulevard and NW 80th Avenue and authorize a Town wide Transportation Traffic Study for a total of \$8,400.00. The motion received a second from Mayor Pizzi and all voted in favor.
