1. **CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Slaton called the meeting to order at 5:43 p.m.

2. **ROLL CALL:**

The Town Clerk, Marjorie Tejeda-Castillo, called the roll with the following Councilmembers present: Frank Mingo, Nelson Rodriguez, Tony Lama, Ceasar Mestre, Tim Daubert, Vice Mayor Manny Cid and Mayor Wayne Slaton.

3. **INVOCATION/MOMENT OF SILENCE:**

Mayor Slaton led the invocation.

4. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:**

Mayor Slaton led the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Alex Ariano spoke in opposition to various expenditures undertaken by the Council, such as a four percent increase in law enforcement, the *Amicus Brief* for the Town to seek further legal counsel, the soaring crime rate, as well as fees and/or fines that residents have to incur.

Hope Reynolds voiced her opposition with respect to the Council and administration's quest to seek extra revenue at the expense of taxpayers.

Jan Schneider shared her disapproval regarding the Council's decision to pursue legal counsel despite the substantial opposition expressed at August 27th Special Call meeting. She quoted John Adams, "Liberty cannot be preserved without general knowledge among people," thereby implying that the Council has neglected to heed the residents' will and respond to the questions and concerns of these residents.

Paula Hagen commended the Council for its worthy job and shared the impact that waste hauling fees would have on Celebration Pointe inhabitants.
