1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Pizzi called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL:

The Town Clerk, Marjorie Tejeda-Castillo, called the roll with the following Councilmembers present: Tony Lama, Nelson Rodriguez, Tim Daubert, Vice Mayor Manny Cid, and Mayor Michael Pizzi. Councilmembers Ceasar Mestre and Frank Mingo were absent.

3. MOMENT OF SILENCE

Mayor asked that there be a moment of silence in honor of Councilman Frank Mingo's father, Serafin Mingo, and Sergio Campos.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Mr. Sean Schwinghammer led the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. SPECIAL PRESENTATION:

The Mayor and Council proclaimed May 5th, 2015 as Sergio Campos Day in the Town of Miami Lakes.

The Mayor and Council presented an award to Gloria Garcia for her outstanding participation and support in the 2015 Relay for Life in the Town of Miami Lakes.

The Mayor and Council presented the Future Leader Scholarship Award to Kaitlin Castillo and Sharon Zajac on behalf of the Education Advisory Board and the Graham Companies.

The Mayor and Council proclaimed May 5th forever in the Town of Miami Lakes as Major Gene Dieppa Day.

6. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Christopher Norwood spoke in favor of Mayor Pizzi's return to office, welcoming him back.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 8 "CODE ENFORCEMENT" OF THE TOWN'S CODE TO PROVIDE FOR CIVIL PENALTY REDUCTIONS BY THE HEARING OFFICER; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. The Town Attorney, Raul Gastesi, read the title of the ordinance into the record.

Councilman Daubert made a motion to adopt the ordinance on first reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Rodriguez. The Town Clerk called the roll and the motion passed 3-2. The following Councilmembers voted in opposition: Vice

Mayor Cid and Mayor Pizzi. Councilman Mingo and Councilman Mestre were absent.

12. ORDINANCES-SECOND READING (PUBLIC HEARING):

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14-174, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 15-181; AMENDING THE TOWN'S FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Councilman Daubert made a motion to adopt the ordinance on second reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Lama. The Town Clerk called the roll and the motion passed 4-0. Councilman Mingo and Councilman Mestre were absent. Mayor Pizzi recused himself.

13. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Support for Free Market Principles: Uber and Lyft (Lama)

Councilman Lama made a motion to direct the Town Attorney to draft a resolution in strong support of Uber and Lyft services both in the Town and County. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Cid and all were in favor. Councilman Mingo and Councilman Mestre were absent.

B. Town of Miami Lakes – MD Fire Rescue (Cid, Rodriguez)

Vice Mayor Cid made a motion directing the Town Manager to have a discussion with the Miami Dade Fire Chief in reference to additional resources for the Town, coming back to the Council with a report. The motion was seconded by Councilman Rodriguez and all were in favor. Councilman Mingo and Councilman Mestre were absent.

D. Miami Lakes Non-Profit Organizations (Cid)

Vice Mayor Cid withdrew this item.

E. Co-designating Loch Ness Drive as Sergio Campos Way (Cid, Mestre, Rodriguez, Daubert, Lama, Pizzi, Mingo)

Vice Mayor Cid made a motion to bring back a resolution to the Council co-designating Loch Ness Drive as Sergio Campos Way. Councilman Lama seconded the motion and all were in favor. Councilman Mingo and Councilman Mestre were absent.
