## Qualifications

To qualify for the SIP, a student must be currently enrolled in or have been enrolled in a parks and recreation/sport management degree program in their college or university. In addition, the student must have:

- Excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills.
- Ability to problem-solve and to complete projects within specified timeframes.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees at all levels, with staff at partner organizations, and with the public.
- Ability to self-motivate and work productively independently or with a team.
- Working knowledge of Word and Excel.

Work Hours: 20 hours per week, potential for additional hours. Internships require a minimum commitment of three months. (Flexible schedule)
