

RESOLUTION NO. 01- 11

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE, THE STATE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER, THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL AND ALL OTHER APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS IN THEIR EFFORTS TO PROVIDE RELIEF TO THE TOWN'S CITIZENS FROM THE EFFECTS OF BLASTING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that blasting is an ultrahazardous activity that adversely affects the health, safety and welfare of the Town's citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Miami Lakes would continue to be adversely affected by any future blasting;

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that the effects of blasting have caused substantial damage to property owned by residents of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to ensure that there shall be no further blasting that adversely affects the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby requests that efforts be taken by the State Legislature, the State Insurance Commissioner, the State Fire Marshal and all other appropriate officials to provide relief to the Town's citizens from the effects of blasting.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
