RESOLUTION NO. 01-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES A "PROJECT IMPACT PARTNER" WITH THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROJECT IMPACT COMMUNITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the "Local Mitigation Strategy" was developed by public and private sector partnerships to reduce the risks and damages resulting from the various types of disasters faced by the residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy was developed by public and private sector partnerships to develop risk reduction initiatives for the residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, because of the success of the risk reduction initiatives developed by the Local Mitigation Strategy, Miami-Dade County has been designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a "Project Impact Community"; and

WHEREAS, to date, Miami-Dade County is the largest community chosen to be a member of Project Impact; and

WHEREAS, this designation as a Project Impact Community will support the development of Local Mitigation Strategy initiatives in the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council supports the efforts of the Miami-Dade Project Impact Community and the Miami-Dade County Office of Emergency Management to educate the residents of the Town of Miami Lakes and Miami-Dade County on how to reduce their risks from the various types of natural disasters faced by this community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town is hereby declared to be a "Project Impact Partner" with the Miami-Dade County Project Impact Community and the Town Council pledges its support to Project Impact and the Local Mitigation Strategy.

Section 2. The Town Council urges the Miami-Dade County Project Impact Community and the Miami-Dade County Office of Emergency Management to coordinate efforts throughout the following year that will educate all residents of the Town and the County on how to reduce their risks from natural disasters.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
