RESOLUTION NO. 01-19

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION AND THE PROJECT CERTIFICATION FORM TO THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO ENABLE THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES TO OBTAIN ITS STATUTORY SHARE OF THE ONE TO FIVE CENTS LOCAL OPTION FUEL TAX IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 336.025(4)(b) AND 206.41 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES TO BE UTILIZED FOR RESIDENTIAL AND FEEDER ROAD RESURFACING PROJECTS WITHIN THE TOWN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") to submit a Project Certification Form to the Metropolitan Planning Organization of Miami-Dade County to obtain its statutory share of the one to five cents local option fuel tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the elected body of each participating municipality must approve a plan for the expenditure of the one to five cents local option fuel tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the one to five cents local option fuel tax shall be utilized and expended by the Town for road projects as defined by the Florida Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Town Manager is authorized to transmit a copy of this Resolution and the Project Certification Form to the Metropolitan Planning Organization of Miami-Dade County to enable the Town to obtain its statutory share of the one to five cents local option fuel tax, in accordance with Sections 336.025(4)(b) and 206.41 of the Florida Statutes, to be expended for residential and feeder road resurfacing projects within the Town. The Town Manager shall further request that the Metropolitan Planning Organization of Miami-Dade

County take all steps necessary to provide the Florida Department of Revenue (the "Department") with all necessary and appropriate information so that the distribution of fuel tax revenues may be remitted directly to the Town by the Department.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


