

RESOLUTION NO. 02- 107

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO DISBURSE FUNDS ALLOCATED IN THE 2002-2003 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO LOCAL SCHOOLS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes Education Advisory Board (the “Board”) has recommended that the Town Council appropriate funds to be distributed to local schools to assist those schools in maintaining or attaining an “A ” grade under the State of Florida rating system for schools; and

WHEREAS, funds have been allocated in the 2002-2003 General Fund Budget to go toward this purpose.

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the disbursement of these funds to Town schools is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization to Disburse Funds. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to disburse funds to the corresponding schools located within the Town of Miami Lakes, as specified by the attached Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
