WHEREAS, Maida E. Williams has earned the respect and admiration of students, faculty, colleagues, and the community; and


WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to honor and congratulate Maida E. Williams.


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by reference.
