## RESOLUTION NO. 04-215

A RESOLTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING THE EFFORTS OF THE MIAMI COALITION FOR A SAFE AND DRUG-FREE COMMUNITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Miami Coalition for a Safe and Drug-Free Community conducted a Survey of public and parochial students in Miami Dade County; and

WHEREAS, The survey revealed that local youth have achieved the goal of the community's 10-year prevention plan **two-years early** with the most significant declines occurring between 2001 and 2003; and

WHEREAS, working together to deliver a consistent anti-drug message in our schools, in our houses of worship and our workplaces, through the media, in our homes and neighborhoods and elsewhere, has shown positive results for our youth; and

WHEREAS, we must continue these efforts as new students enter and exit our education systems

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town of Miami Lakes hereby recognizes the efforts of the Miami Coalition for a Safe and Drug-Free Community and urges the coalition to continue their efforts

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
