A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING THE REQUEST OF ALBERTO FERRER TO REDUCE A PREVIOUSLY ASSESSED CODE ENFORCEMENT FINE FOR CASE NO. C2003-2198; DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town"), thought its Code Enforcement Department, issued Citation No. C2003-2198 to Alberto Ferrer (the "Violator"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-195, the Town Manager is authorized to reduce a Code Enforcement Citation fine by 50% provided that the violation has been complied with by the Violator; and

WHEREAS, the Violator previously entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Town Manager pursuant to Resolution No. 04-195 and has paid the Town \$5,250.00 which is one half of the original fine; and

WHEREAS, the Violator has requested that the Town further reduce the fine and the Town Manager having reviewed the file has recommended to the Town Council approval of a reduction of the fine to \$1,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Reduction of Fine. The civil penalty/fine for Code Enforcement Case No. C2003-2198 is reduced to \$1,500.00. The Town Manager is authorized to execute

appropriate documents to facilitate the return of the balance of already paid fines to the Violator.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
