RESOLUTION NO. 04-232

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING THE REQUEST OF OCEANMAR WAREHOUSE II TO REDUCE A PREVIOUSLY ASSESSED CODE ENFORCEMENT FINE FOR CASE NO. C2003-0240; DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town"), thought its Code Enforcement Department, issued Citation No. C2003-0240 to Oceanmar Warehouse II (the "Violator"); and

WHEREAS, the Town's Special Master issued an Order Imposing Civil Penalties against the Violator, the violations were subsequently corrected and the Violator paid the Town the fine of \$11,151.00; and

WHEREAS, the Violator has requested that the Town reduce the fine and the Town Manager having reviewed the file has recommended to the Town Council approval of a reduction of the fine to \$5,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Reduction of Fine. The civil penalty/fine for Code Enforcement Case No. C2003-0240 is reduced to \$5,000.00. The Town Manager is authorized to execute appropriate documents to facilitate the return of the balance of already paid fines to the Violator.
