

RESOLUTION NO. 04- 238

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, OPPOSING PLACEMENT OF ROCK MINING CLOSER TO RESIDENTIAL AREAS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes residents have long suffered the effects of blasting associated with rock mining; and

WHEREAS, the placement of rock mining operations in close proximity to homes causes health, safety and property hazards; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission is currently considering the placement of rock mining in closer proximity to homes that has previously existed; and

WHEREAS, the justifications offered by the County do not overcome the adverse consequences to her effected homeowners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town of Miami Lakes Town Council opposes any County plans to place rock mining in close proximity to residential development.


Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




