RESOLUTION NO. 06-<u>311</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA; SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO PROVIDE A POINT OF DISTRIBUTION SITE FOR DISASTER RELIEF SUPPLIES WITHIN THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County government is responsible for selecting sites for distribution of disaster relief supplies such as ice, water and food to citizens after disastrous events such as hurricanes; and,

WHEREAS, many Miami Lakes citizens do not have the means to travel outside the Town to obtain much needed basic supplies, especially after a disaster; and

WHEREAS, when a post-disaster curfew has been imposed, it further limits the time available to obtain relief supplies; and

WHEREAS, establishing a point of distribution within the Town of Miami Lakes would make essential provisions more available to the Town residents and, in turn, reduce the burden on other points of distribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Town Manager negotiate with Miami-Dade County for a point of distribution for disaster relief supplies including the potential use of town-owned property for such a site.

Section 2. This resolution be effective upon adoption hereof.
