

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-317**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA; SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO PROVIDE A POINT OF DISTRIBUTION SITE FOR DISASTER RELIEF SUPPLIES WITHIN THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES.**

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County government is responsible for selecting sites for distribution of disaster relief supplies such as ice, water and food to citizens after disastrous events such as hurricanes; and,

**WHEREAS**, many Miami Lakes citizens do not have the means to travel outside the Town to obtain much needed basic supplies, especially after a disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, when a post-disaster curfew has been imposed, it further limits the time available to obtain relief supplies; and

**WHEREAS**, establishing a point of distribution within the Town of Miami Lakes would make essential provisions more available to the Town residents and, in turn, reduce the burden on other points of distribution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The Town Manager negotiate with Miami-Dade County for a point of distribution for disaster relief supplies including the potential use of town-owned property for such a site.

**Section 2.** This resolution be effective upon adoption hereof.
