WHEREAS, the Violator have requested that the Town reduce the fine and the Town Manager having reviewed the file has recommended to the Town Council approval of a reduction of the fine to \$5,873.52.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals.</u> The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Reduction of Fine. The civil penalty/fine for Code Enforcement Case No. C2004-0206 is reduced to \$5,873.52. The Town Manager is authorized to execute appropriate documents to facilitate the return of the balance of already paid fines to the Violators.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
