RESOLUTION NO. 08-623

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA APPROVING THE PROJECT PROPOSAL BETWEEN ACOSTA TRACTORS. INC. AND THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES FOR SITE PREPARATION FOR POCKET PARKS P17, P18, P22, L22, P32, L41, P23, AND P78; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND TOWN ATTORNEY TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROJECT PROPOSAL; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO BUDGETED **FUNDS: AUTHORIZING** MANAGER TO **EXECUTE** THE PROPOSAL AND ANY EXTENSIONS; AUTHORIZING THE **TOWN** MANAGER TO **PURCHASE PREPARATION SERVICES FROM ACOSTA** ADDITIONAL POCKET PARKS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") has retained Acosta Tractors, Inc., ("Acosta") under an Agreement for Public Works General Construction Services to provide general construction and drainage services throughout the Town ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that Acosta may perform construction related tasks to various Town facilities and structures; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, in Resolution No. 06-449 previously approved proposals from Acosta to perform site preparation for four (4) Pocket Parks; and

WHEREAS, Acosta has provided the Town with a proposal to perform site preparation services for eight (8) additional Pocket Parks for the renovation of recreation equipment made in accordance with the Agreement (the "Project Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that approval of the Project Proposal between Acosta and the Town is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Approval of Project Proposal. The Project Proposal between Acosta Tractors, Inc. and the Town of Miami Lakes for the site preparation, which includes removal and disposal of existing recreation equipment, of Pocket Parks: P17, P18, P22, L22, P32, L41, P23 and P78 (the "Project Proposal"), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A," together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the Town Manager and approved as to form and legality by the Town Attorney, is approved.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Authorization of Town Officials.</u> The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the Project Proposal.

Section 4. Authorization of Fund Expenditure. Notwithstanding the limitations imposed upon the Town Manager pursuant to the Town's Purchasing Procedures Ordinance, the Town Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds to implement the terms and conditions of the Project Proposal. As additional funds become available, the Town Manager is authorized to expend these additional funds to utilize Acosta to perform site preparation work for the following Pocket Parks; P67, P10, P2 (Loch Lomond), P12, P70, P80, P20, P24, P82, P15, P30.

Section 5. Execution of Project Proposal. The Town Manager is authorized to execute the Project Proposal on behalf of the Town, to execute any required agreements and/or documents to implement the terms and conditions of the Project Proposal and to execute any

extensions and/or amendments to the Project Proposal, and to execute any additional project proposal's to purchase site preparation work from Acosta utilizing the same pricing terms and conditions in the Project Proposal, subject to the approval as to form and legality by the Town Attorney.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
