A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE SOUTH **FLORIDA** MANAGEMENT DISTRICT WATER SAVINGS INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL WATER SAVING IRRIGATION COMPONENTS FOR TOWN PARKS AND/OR RIGHT OF WAYS; AUTHORIZING OFFICIALS TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS **OF** THE APPLICATION: **PROVIDING COMMITMENT** MATCHING **FUNDS:** AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED **FUNDS: AND** PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town desires to a submit a grant application to the South Florida Water Management District Water Savings Incentive Program (the "SFWMD") to aid in the funding of the proposed purchase and installation of water saving irrigation components for Town parks and/or right of ways (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Project cost is estimated to be \$50,000.00, with SFWMD grant funds of approximately 50% of the Project cost equal to \$25,000.00, and the Town's matching funds of approximately 50% of the Project cost equal to \$25,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization for Application. The Town Manager and/or his designee are authorized to apply for a grant from the South Florida Water Management District Water Savings Incentive Program ("SFWMD") for the purchase and installation of water saving irrigation components for Town parks and/or right of ways (the "Project") in the amount of

\$50,000.00, for which 50% or \$25,000.00 would be funded by SFWMD, and in connection with such application to execute such grant agreements and other contracts and documents, to execute any necessary amendments to grant applications and contracts, and take such other acts as may be necessary to bind the Town and accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Authorization of the Town Officials. The Town Manager and Town Section 3. Attorney are authorized to take all actions necessary to move forward with the grant application.

Section 4. Authorization of Matching Funds. If awarded the grant, the Town agrees to commit 50% matching funds in the amount of \$25,000.00.

Authorization Fund Expenditure. The Town Manager is authorized to Section 5. expend budgeted funds to implement the terms and conditions of the grant application.

Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon Section 6. its adoption.
