RESOLUTION NO. 13-1047

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING A REQUEST FROM METROPOLITAN HOMES, LLC TO REDUCE PREVIOUSLY ASSESSED CODE COMPLIANCE FINES FOR CASE NO. C2011-3057; DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes ("Town"), through its Code Compliance Department, issued Citation No. C2011-3057 ("Citation") to Zinovy Briskin and Marina Briskin ("Previous Owners"); and

WHEREAS, the Citation was issued to the Previous Owners but the violations were subsequently corrected by Metropolitan Homes LLC. ("New Owner"); and

WHEREAS, the New Owner has incurred a total fine of \$5,763.83; and

WHEREAS, the New Owner has requested that the Town reduce the fines, and the Town Manager, having reviewed the file, has recommended to the Town Council approval of a reduction of the fine from \$5,763.83 to \$1,272.31 (which is equal to four days of fines and the costs incurred by the Town to process the case); and

WHEREAS, the New Owner has agreed to sign a release of the Town from any claims relating to the Citation as a condition of the reduction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals.</u> The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Reduction of Fine. The civil penalties/fines for Code Compliance Cases No. C2011-3057 are reduced to \$1,272.31 subject to the New Owner paying the reduced amount no later than 60 days from the effective date of this Resolution. The Town

Manager is authorized to execute appropriate documents, including a release and waiver by the New Owner for any and all claims relating to the Citation and this reduction.

Section 3. Conditions. In the event the reduced fine is not paid within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this Resolution, the original fine amount shall be reinstated and continue to accrue interest as if this Resolution had not existed.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
