

RESOLUTION NO. 13-1061

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, URGING SUPPORT OF HB 113, DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS HARMFUL TO MINORS, ADDRESSING VIOLATIONS REGARDING SCHOOL SECURITY POLICIES; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; DIRECTING THE STATE LOBBYIST TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, HB 113 addresses distribution of materials harmful to minors: prohibiting adults from knowingly distributing to minors or posting on school property certain specified materials harmful to minors; and

WHEREAS, one of the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") top concerns and priorities is school safety and security; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to support HB 113, which would elevate to the level of felony any violation of school security policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, HB 113 will enhance school security by deterring individuals from violating school regulations; and

WHEREAS, HB 113 will prohibit individuals from bringing certain items onto school property; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the Towns best interests to support HB 113 for our schools safety and security.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Supporting Adoption of Legislation. The Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes urges the Florida State Legislature to support HB 113, in order to protect and safely secure our schools.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Manager. The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to coordinate with the Town's State Lobbyist to support of HB 113.

Section 4. Transmittal. The Town Manager is authorized to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Town's State Representative.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


