

RESOLUTION NO. 13-1077

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO DIRECT THE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE PLACEMENT OF AN ALL-WAY STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF ALAMANDA AVENUE AND SILVER OAK DRIVE

WHEREAS, the residents of the Lake Hilda area have long requested an all-way stop sign be placed along Alamanda Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Alamanda Avenue is one of the longest stretches (spanning almost ½ miles between Bamboo Street and Miami Lakeway South), without a stop sign in the residential street of Miami Lakes; and

WHEREAS, due to the length of the street, speeding has become a dangerous problem to the residents and children along Alamanda Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the safety of the residents and children of Miami Lakes is jeopardized by the lack of traffic calming devices along Alamanda Avenue; and

WHEREAS, safeguarding the youth in our community is a long-term process that is revisited regularly for comprehensive updates and concrete follow-up actions; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes makes every effort to improve the safety of our youth and residents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes requests the County Mayor to direct the County Public Works department to authorize the placement of an all-way stop sign at the intersection of Alamanda Avenue and Silver Oak Drive.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


