CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Slaton called the meeting to order on Tuesday, August 14, 2001 at 4: 30 p.m.

POLICE STAFFING REVIEW: The Town Manager distributed a table depicting the Town of Miami Lakes Police Staffing Costs and a Miami-Dade County Police Department Summary of Overhead Calculations for the Town of Miami Lakes (*attached hereto these fully executed minutes.*).

Jane Feuer reviewed the proposed staffing costs noting that the summary includes six categories set forth therein as follows: 1. Countywide; 2. Attributable to a large department; 3. Direct Patrol/Other Costs; 4. Direct Non-Patrol; 5. Direct Optional Services, and 6. Overhead.

Total personnel and Staffing was proposed as follows: Uniform Officers: four (4) Sergeants; Twenty-Seven 27 Officers; Four (4) Bicycle Officers; One (1) Motorcycle Officer and One (1) public Service Aide plus for the General Investigation Unit: One (1) sergeant and (3) detectives.

ADJOURNMENT: The Mayor adjourned the meeting at 6:45 p.m.
