POLICE STAFFING REVIEW: The Town Manager distributed a table depicting the Town of Miami Lakes Police Staffing Costs and a Miami-Dade County Police Department Summary of Overhead Calculations for the Town of Miami Lakes (attached hereto these fully executed minutes.).

Jane Feuer reviewed the proposed staffing costs noting that the summary includes six categories set forth therein as follows: 1. Countywide; 2. Attributable to a large department; 3. Direct Patrol/Other Costs; 4. Direct Non-Patrol; 5. Direct Optional Services, and 6. Overhead.

Total personnel and Staffing was proposed as follows: Uniform Officers: four (4) Sergeants; Twenty-Seven 27 Officers; Four (4) Bicycle Officers; One (1) Motorcycle Officer and One (1) public Service Aide plus for the General Investigation Unit: One (1) sergeant and (3) detectives.
