

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, SUNSETTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SHERIFF ORDINANCE AD-HOC REVIEW COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2022, the Town of Miami Lakes (the “Town”) Council met, and by motion created the Miami-Dade County Sheriff Ordinance Review Committee (the “Committee”); and

WHEREAS, during the past two years the Committee has met to discuss various police service options for the Town, has studied legislation moving through the Florida legislature and discussed the item with local, regional and State officials; and

WHEREAS, given the Town’s position to continue receiving local police services from the Miami Dade County Police Department vis Interlocal Agreement through September 30, 2029, the Town Council’s decision to not fund the study to consider the creation of our police department and the legislation established, it is recommended that the committee be sunset

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. **Sunset Provision.** The Committee has completed its purpose and shall sunset.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


