

RESOLUTION NO. 26-2164

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO SOLITUDE LAKE MANAGEMENT AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR ITB 2026-04 LAKE MAINTENANCE SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND ANY RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the “Town”) requires lake maintenance services to preserve water quality, environmental health, and the aesthetic condition of lakes located within the Town’s Lake Maintenance Service Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Town issued Invitation to Bid (“ITB”) No. 2026-04 for Lake Maintenance Services on January 19, 2026, which was published in the Community Newspapers, posted on DemandStar, Public Purchase, and posted in the Government Center lobby in accordance with applicable procurement requirements; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened on February 19, 2026, and the Town received three (3) bids from the following firms:

Solitude Lake Management – \$102,600.00
Southeast Land and Water Management, LLC – \$396,000.00
Tigris Aquatic Services, LLC – \$274,800.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town’s Procurement Division reviewed the bids for responsiveness and responsibility and determined that Solitude Lake Management submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid and meets all qualifications required by the ITB; and

WHEREAS, Town staff reviewed the bid submitted by Solitude Lake Management and confirmed that the pricing submitted is accurate and determined that the bid pricing is fair and reasonable for the services to be provided; and

WHEREAS, the Town conducted the procurement process in accordance with applicable Town purchasing policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, Solitude Lake Management has extensive experience providing lake maintenance services, has been in business for more than twenty-seven (27) years, and provided references demonstrating experience with contracts of similar size, scope, and complexity; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that awarding the contract to Solitude Lake Management is in the best interest of the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. **Authorization to Award Contract.** The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to award a contract to Solitude Lake Management as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for ITB 2026-04 Lake Maintenance Services in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds.

Section 3. **Authorization to Execute Contract.** The Town Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract and any related documents necessary to effectuate the award and implement the project, subject to review and approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the

Town Attorney. The Town Manager is further authorized to execute any extensions and/or amendments to the contract that do not materially increase the approved contract amount, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the Town Attorney.

Section 4. Authorization to Implement Contract and Expend Funds.

The Town Manager is further authorized to take all actions necessary to implement and administer the contract and to expend budgeted funds in connection therewith.


Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

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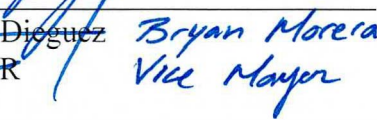

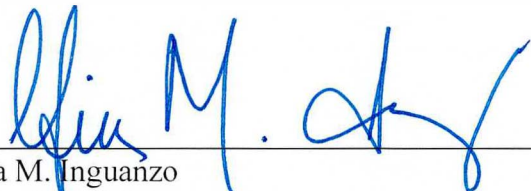

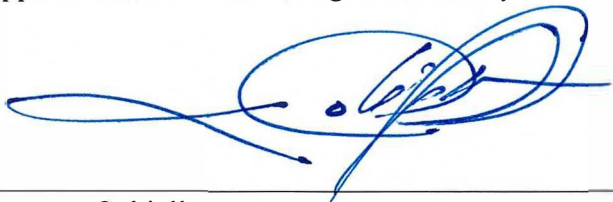
