

ORDINANCE NO. 26-358

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET ADOPTED IN ORDINANCE 2025-346, TO RECOGNIZE AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS AWARDED TO THE TOWN BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT UNDER THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE INCREASE OF GENERAL FUND REVENUES AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR THOUSAND, FIFTY FOUR DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$4,054.00) AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT;; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") adopted its Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Operating Budget via Ordinance 2025-346; and

WHEREAS, the Town received a grant from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program for the purchase of police equipment, including a vehicle-mounted speed measuring device and rechargeable flashlights for night deputies; and

WHEREAS, the total grant award is Four Thousand Fifty-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,054.00); and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are to be recognized as General Fund revenue under account number 001-331202-G2506 (E. Byrne Memorial Grant – JAGD) and appropriated for expenditure under account number 0012102-555500-G2506 (Police Emergency Equipment – Non-Capital Outlay); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it necessary and appropriate to amend the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Operating Budget to recognize and appropriate said grant funds, all as more particularly set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town of Miami Lakes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. Each of the above stated recitals is true and correct and is incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authority. The Town Council is authorized to amend the Town’s annual operating budget pursuant to Section 166.241, Florida Statutes, and the Town of Miami Lakes Charter.

Section 3. Budget Amendment. The Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Operating Budget, adopted via Ordinance 2025-346 of the Town of Miami Lakes is hereby amended to recognize and appropriate Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program funds awarded by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement in the amount of Four Thousand Fifty-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,054.00), all as more particularly set forth in the line-item detail attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Implementation. The Town Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the budget amendment set forth herein, including making the corresponding entries to the appropriate revenue and expenditure accounts of the Town.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All provisions of the Code of the Town of Miami Lakes and all ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption on second reading.

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FIRST READING

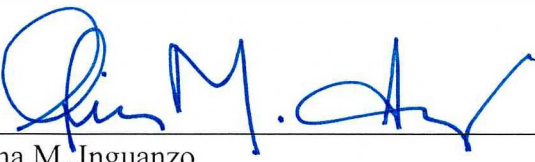
